**Professor Dr Andreas Diekmann  
Leipzig University**

Professor Andreas Diekmann is senior professor of sociology at Leipzig University and professor emeritus at the ETH Zurich. He was a Fellow of the Institute for Advanced Study Berlin and serves currently as a chairperson of the class Humanities, Social and Behavioural Sciences of the German National Academy of Sciences, Leopoldina. His research interests include theories of social cooperation, experimental game theory, environmental research and the methodology of empirical social research. In the area of methodological research, Professor Diekmann focuses on models of social interactions, anonymization techniques in surveys, and statistical methods for detecting data falsification.
