The stereotypical national in Europe: How cultural stereotypes impact public opinion on European integration

Dr Adina Akbik
Senior Assistant Professor | Leiden University

Adina Akbik is Senior Assistant Professor of European Politics at the University of Leiden. Her main research interests focus on European Union (EU) institutions, policymaking, and accountability. Since 2024, she is leading a large project on the role of cultural stereotypes in EU governance, funded by European Research Council (ERC).

Cultural stereotypes are everywhere in Europe: in jokes, media, politics, and art. Which stereotypes are relevant for EU cooperation, and how do stereotypes relate to citizens' preferences on EU decision-making? This lecture presents the results of a survey on the topic conducted in 4 countries: Germany, Italy, Romania, and Sweden.
