



Registration for Classes and Exams at the Chair of Comparative Politics

The registration for all modules offered by the Chair of Comparative Politics is done via FlexNow. However, you only register for exams and not for the classes themselves.

Consequently, you only have to register for a lecture-based module if you intend to take the exam and earn credit points for it.

These are the deadlines you have to follow when registering for any exams at our chair (different deadlines may apply for other chairs):

| Seminars, advanced seminars, tutorials | 1 April / 1 October | Two weeks after the teaching period starts | Two weeks after the teaching period starts |

If you do not cancel your registration by the deadline listed above and if you do not fulfill the requirements to pass the module, you will fail it meaning that you will have to repeat it. The number of times you can repeat a module is limited by the exam regulations.

If you are studying in a Bachelors- or Masters course, you have to repeat failed classes within the maximum study period. Since lecture-based modules are only offered every other semester, you are provided with the opportunity to re-take the exam at the beginning of the following semester.
